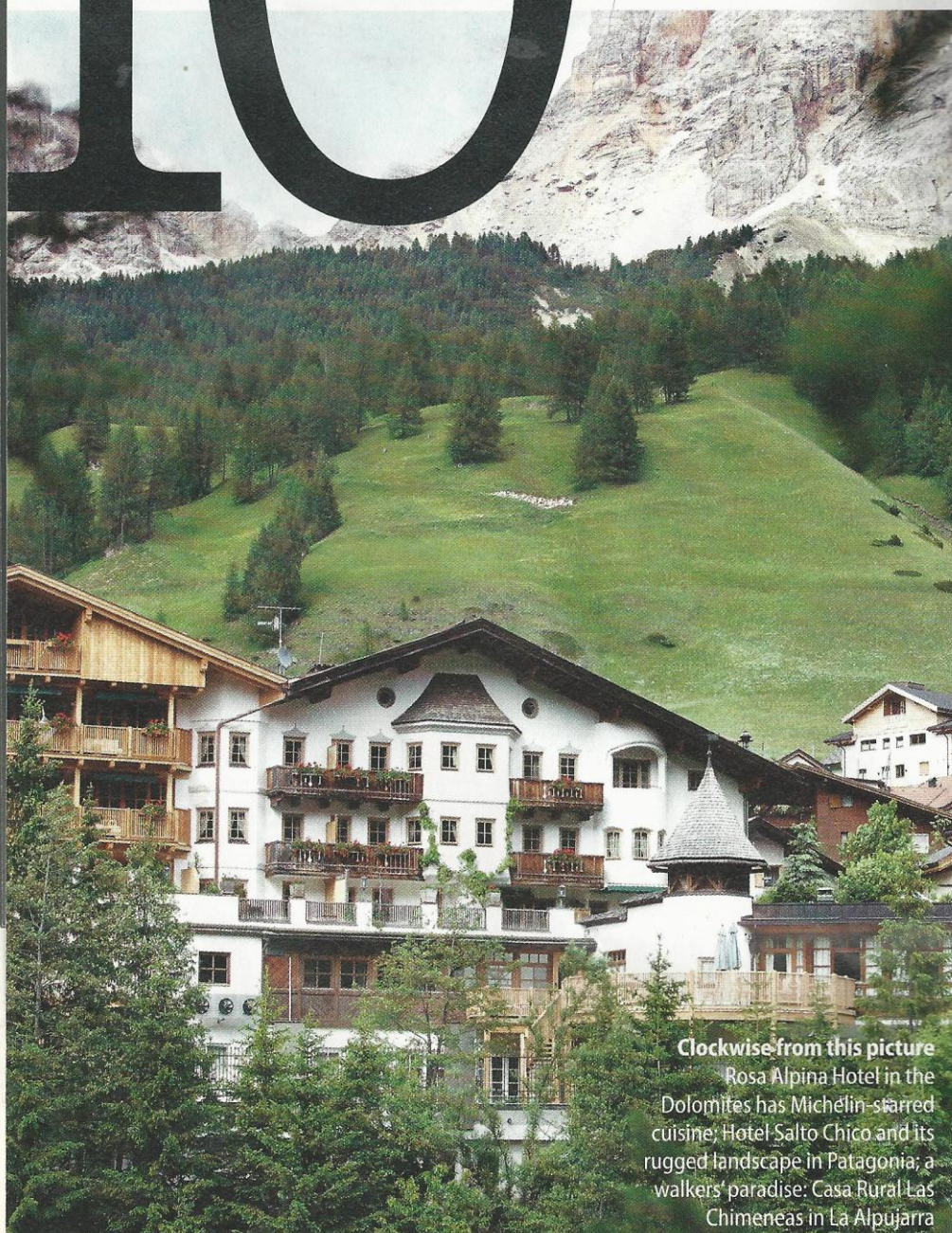

CASA RURAL LAS CHIMENEAS LA ALPUJARRA, SPAIN

The British couple who run this rustic-chic guesthouse in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada are a mine of information on walks in the area, supplying guests with detailed route notes, maps and if needed a packed lunch. Walks go straight from the house but transport and baggage transfers can be arranged for guests wishing to tackle longer walks such as the GR7 long-distance footpath, which passes the hotel. UMA PARO BHUTAN

The emphasis is on exploring the great outdoors at this understated but stylish mountain lodge in the ancient Himalayan kingdom of Bhutan. Don't miss the opportunity to take the two-hour hike up to the Taksang Monastery, also known as the Tiger's Nest, which is perched on a cliff 900m above the Paro Valley.
